Judging Guidelines:

- 5 scones presented for judging
- Scones should be approximately 5 cms in diameter
- Well risen, straight sides, thin golden crust top & bottom, no flour base
- Fine, moist texture, good crumb, good flavour & according to type
- Alternating each year between Sweet and Savoury - 2011 Sweet
- Best variation of the nominated scone recipe using "Laucke Country Women's Scone Mix"

General Outline:

- Level 1 - Local:
Country Women's Scone Mix competition to be conducted and judged at each Local Agricultural Show
- Level 2 - Association:
The winners from each of the Local shows to be eligible to enter and be judged at the appropriate Association show
- Level 3 - State Bake off:
The 10 Association winners to be eligible to enter a bake off as part of the Royal Adelaide Show for a state winner,

** Note: As scones need to be judged while they are fresh, and respecting the difficulties involved with association winners being able to bake at home and deliver in a timely manner to the Royal Adelaide Show on the appropriate day, the State final will need to be run as a "bake-off" event. This would involve all association winners baking their scones in a kitchen area within Adelaide. The scones would then be taken to the Royal Adelaide Show for judging and display. This event will be timed to coincide with the judging of the Genoa and Rich Fruit Cake Competitions.
